Our Drawing & Painting Skills Folio Classes offer a flexible, student-led approach where young artists can explore drawing, painting, or a combination of both across the term. Each session begins with 20 minutes of guided technique exercises, building strong foundational skills in areas such as shading, proportion, colour mixing, brushwork, linework, and observation. These structured warm-ups are designed to boost confidence while introducing essential artistic techniques in a fun and accessible way.

In the remainder of the class, students are supported to develop their own creative projects. Artists can choose to focus on drawing, painting, or move fluidly between the two — even combining mediums within a single artwork. Whether they're creating realistic studies, exploring manga or kawaii styles, experimenting with abstract or surrealist ideas, or developing characters and stories, each student is encouraged to follow their interests and bring their ideas to life.

Throughout the term, there are also opportunities to explore additional mediums such as clay, oil pastels, and construction using sustainable materials, allowing students to expand their creative thinking and problem-solving skills.

Classes are designed to be supportive, engaging, and inspiring, with each child working at their own level while developing strong artistic foundations. We intentionally limit our group sizes to prioritise step-by-step teaching, personalised attention, and individual support for every artist — helping them grow in skill, confidence, and creative voice.
